CANSKATE:

Our learn to skate program is a progressive badge system that introduces skaters to the basics of skating. In Canskate, Skate Canada stages 1 – 7 will be covered. **Helmets are mandatory for all stages.** After completing Canskate, skaters are ready to move on to “JUNIORS or INTERMEDIATES”, Ringette or Hockey.

- All registrations will be processed on a first come, first served basis
- All VFSC members must pay the \$35.00 Skate Canada Registration and Insurance fee before their first skating session of the year (Sept 1st to Aug 31st). This fee is sent on your behalf to Skate Canada and must only be paid once per season.
- Registrations will NOT be processed and space in the program will not be guaranteed unless forms are completed and credit card numbers or cheques are in place. Skaters will be permitted on the ice only when fees are paid in full. **Form and Payment must be received within 1 week of the reservation or your spot may be filled.**
- Please mark the starting date of your chosen program on your calendar, as reminder calls will not be available.
- **Please call Heather Stranks at 250-260-6632 prior to mailing your registration form** to ensure that there is space available on your chosen session(s) and to reserve your spot.
- Skating days are NOT interchangeable once they are booked
- A charge of \$25.00 will be applied to all NSF cheques. Additionally, your skater will be suspended from on ice activities as long as NSF cheques remain outstanding
- Refunds will be granted if 50% or more of the classes are missed for medical reasons, and a 10% administration fee will be deducted. A doctor's certificate will be required.
- **Schedule subject to change.** Vernon Figure Skating Club will not be held responsible for loss of ice or cancellations beyond our control.
